# **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### 1. RULES

1.1 The British Moth Sea Championship will be governed by "the rules" as defined in the current RYA Racing

#### Rules of Sailing

- 1.2 The rules of the British Moth Boat Association will apply unless changed by these Sailing instructions or any changes at pre-race Briefings.
- 1.3 All competitors are required to compete in compliance with the RYA Racing Charter.

#### 2. NOTICES FOR COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Notices to competitors (NOR) and any amendments to these Sailing Instructions (SI's) will be posted on the notice board in Fowey Gallants S.C.
- 2.2 Helms intending to race shall complete an entry form and pay the appropriate fee.

#### 3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted on the notice board no later than 1 hour before the start of scheduled racing on the day it will take effect or will be notified at any pre-race Briefings on or off the water.

#### 4. SIGNALS

4.1 All Race Signals will be displayed on the Committee Boat.

#### 5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 5.1 The schedule of races and number of races to qualify are published in the Notice of Race.
- 5.2 Extra races may be sailed on any day.

#### 6. CLASS FLAGS

6.1 Class Flags to be used will be announced at the race briefing.

#### 7. RACE AREA

7.1 The race area includes the whole harbour and estuary.

#### 8. COURSE

8.1 The Course will be displayed on the committee boat on a course board, which will display the number of Laps, and the order and direction marks are to be rounded. Letter G indicates a gate. When displayed, the gate is a mark of the course, and boats must pass through the gate on the windward leg of each lap.

8.2 The Race Officer may change the course before the warning signal by breaking out flag L and displaying the new course.





#### 9. MARKS

9.1 Marks to be used will be notified at the pre-race briefing.

#### 10. THE START

- 10.1 The starting line will be between a staff on the committee boat and an outer distance mark.
- 10.2 An inner distance mark may be used. If used, any boat passing between the inner distance mark and the committee boat will be deemed not to have started until she re-rounds either the committee boat or the outer distance mark and crosses the start line.

#### 11. THE FINISH

11.1 The finish line will be the start line or the line between a staff on the committee boat and the nearest mark of the course.

#### 12. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

12.1 Protests are discouraged. Arbitration is recommended if deemed to be essential.

#### 13. SCORING

13.1 The low point scoring system will apply.
0.75 for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3 for 3<sup>rd</sup> and so on.
OCS + 1, Retirements + 1, DNF + 1, Disqualified x 2

#### 14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors compete in the racing entirely at their own risk. The organising authority, race officer,

rescue crews and host clubs will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the races.

#### 15. INSURANCE

15.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000.



# **Notice of Race**

#### Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> May 2016

#### 1. RYA Racing Charter



1.1 Competitors should note that the British Moth Boat Association implement the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the current RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing) or at www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter

#### 2. Rules

2.1 Races will be governed by the "Rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing except if they are changed by the sailing instructions, class rules, the prescriptions of the RYA and this Notice of Race.

#### 3. Condition of Entry

- 3.1 The safety of the boat and its entire management, including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the competitor racing the boat.
- 3.2 All craft on the club premises (on land and on the water) must have full insurance cover, including third party liability to £2,000,000. All craft intended to be used for racing must have appropriate insurance cover.
- 3.3 The race organisers, race officer, rescue crew or host clubs, shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner-competitor, as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his boat for the race or races.

#### 4. Organising Authority

4.1 The organising authority is the British Moth Boat Association.

#### 5. Safety Regulations

5.1. All competitors shall wear adequate personal buoyancy at all times whilst afloat.

#### 6. Eligibility

6.1 The open meeting is open to British Moths only.

#### 7. Entry and Registration

- 7.1 Entry fee for the event is £50 (which is inclusive of items and events as listed in the event pre-amble)
- 7.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form and entry fee with the organising authority. Late entries are accepted but event Tee Shirts and Beanie Hats may not be available.



7.3 A valid measurement certificate must be presented if so requested by the organising authority.

#### 8. Event and Programme

- 8.1 Sailing instructions will be available at entry registration on the day of the event.
- 8.2 There will be a briefing for all competitors at 6.00pm on 26/5/16 (Initial Briefing)
- 8.3 5 races are scheduled of which a minimum of 3 shall constitute a series. If 4 races are sailed 3 will count towards each boat's overall result. If 3 races are sailed then all races will count towards each boat's overall result.
- 8.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for each race is as per the sailing programme.

#### 9. Advertising and Sponsorship

9.1 To be announced.

#### 10. The Course

10.1 The courses will be set in and around Fowey Harbour and Estuary.

#### Prizes

The following prizes will be awarded:
